### **Celebrating Birds: The Anguilla National Trust Organises Two Public Events**

As part of the Caribbean Endemic Bird Festival, the Anguilla National Trust has organised two public events:

On Friday 3 June at 6:00pm, Jacques Perrin's "Winged Migration" will be playing at the Teachers Resource Centre. "Winged Migration" is a critically acclaimed documentary film about migratory birds. Cinematographers on planes, gliders, helicopters, and balloons flew over 40 countries and all six continents to capture awe-inspiring and intimate images of these spectacular creatures. The film was nominated for an Academy Award® in 2002 for Best Documentary. Admission is free and refreshments will be provided.

On Saturday 18 June at 6:30am at Road Pond in Sandy Ground, ANT Council President, Karim Hodge, will be conducting a field seminar on bird identification and counting methods. This activity is open to all members of the public. Please bring water and snacks and dress appropriately for the weather. Rain date is scheduled for Saturday 25 June at 6:30am.
