In celebration of Earth Day (which falls on 22 April), the Trust is holding a photo competition. Anyone who enjoys taking photos is encouraged to participate. 8" x 10" prints must be submitted by 19 April for judging. The prize for best photo in two age categories (Under-20 and Over-20) is a Nikon camera (value US\$360) sponsored by Ashley & Sons Ltd. and Cable & Wireless. Support is also being provided by Professional Photos Imaging Centre.
