#### **ANT Announces Earth Day Photo Competition Winners**

In recognition of Earth Day 2006, the Anguilla National Trust held a Photo Competition. With the theme being "Environment and Society," the Trust received 32 submissions in the Over-20 age category and 12 submissions in the Under-20.

The competition was judged by Mrs. Carrolle Devonish (Devonish Art Gallery), Mr. Tarquel Maynard (Professional Photos Imaging Centre), and Mr. Joash Proctor (Department of Youth and Culture). Criteria used to judge the photos ranged from reflection of the theme to photographic skill and manipulation. The winners of the competition were Ms Avenella Griffith (for her photo *Tropicality* in the Over-20 category) and Mr. Leonard Connor (for his photo *A Glimpse Into The Past* in the Under-20 category). Ms Griffith and Mr. Connor each won a Nikon digital camera (value US\$360). The cameras were sponsored by Ashley & Sons Ltd. and Cable & Wireless.
