ALHCS Environmental Club partners with the ANT to determine Anguilla's environmental priorities

Students from the ALHCS Environmental Club are once again helping the Anguilla National Trust to collect important information about Anguilla's natural environment and Anguillians' relationship with it. Throughout the week, students have been conducting a national survey designed to determine what environmental issues and problems Anguillians are most concerned about. The information collected will be analysed by the Anguilla National Trust and the results will feed into a Country Programme Strategy.

The Strategy is part of an initiative that the ANT is implementing with the help of the United Nations Development Programme's Global Environment Facility Small Grants Programme (GEF SGP). The GEF SGP provides financial and technical assistance to non-government and community-based organisations for projects which conserve and restore the environment and which also enhance people's well-being and livelihoods. The Strategy, which will take approximately three months to develop, is meant to guide organisations in Anguilla as they seek funding from the GEF SGP.
